

Means by which States Can Combat Intolerance, Discrimination, and Violence against Persons based on Race, Color, Descent, or National or Ethnic Origin ("Race")

Express concern about incidents of racial intolerance, discrimination and related violence, as well as stereotyping of individuals on the basis of race, and condemn, in this context, any advocacy of racial hatred against individuals that constitutes incitement to discrimination, hostility or violence and take effective measures, as set forth herein, consistent with their obligations under international human rights law, to address and combat such incidents

Condemn any advocacy of racial hatred that constitutes incitement to discrimination, hostility or violence, whether it involves the use of print, audio-visual or electronic media or any other means

Encourage training of government officials in effective outreach strategies

Encourage efforts of leaders to discuss within their communities causes of discrimination and evolving strategies to counter these causes

Speak out against intolerance, including advocacy of racial hatred that constitutes incitement to discrimination, hostility or violence;

Adopt measures to criminalize incitement to imminent violence based on race

Understand the need to combat denigration and stereotyping of persons, as well as incitement to hatred, based on race by strategizing and harmonizing actions at the local, national, regional and international levels through, inter alia, education and awareness-building

Recognize that the open, constructive and respectful debate of ideas, as well as dialog, at the local, national and international levels, can play a positive role in combating racial hatred, incitement and violence

Take effective measures to ensure that public functionaries in the conduct of their public duties do not discriminate against an individual on the basis of race

Encourage representation and meaningful participation of individuals, irrespective of their race, in all sectors of society

Undertake a strong effort to counter racial profiling, which is understood to be the invidious use of race as a criterion in conducting questionings, searches and other law enforcement investigative procedures

Consider providing updates on efforts made in this regard as part of ongoing reporting to the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights
