- 1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring), That it is the sense of Congress that—*
3 (1) the State of Israel is not a racist or apart-
4 heid state;
5 (2) Congress rejects all forms of antisemitism
6 and xenophobia; and

1 (3) the United States will always be a staunch
2 partner and supporter of Israel.
