16/... Mandate of the Special Rapporteur on contemporary forms of racism, racial discrimination, xenophobia and related intolerance

The Human Rights Council

Bearing in mind paragraph 6 of General Assembly resolution 60/251 of 15 March 2006,

Reaffirming the **obligations of states under** relevant international human rights instruments, in particular the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination, proclaimed adopted by the General Assembly in its resolution 2106 (XX) of 20 December 1965,

Reaffirming also Recalling all previous resolutions and decisions of the General Assembly, the Commission on Human Rights and the Human Rights Council on the elimination of racism, racial discrimination, xenophobia and related intolerance, in particular Council resolution 7/34 of 28 March 2008,

Recalling Council resolutions 5/1 on institution-building of the United Nations Human Rights Council and 5/2 on the code of conduct for special procedures mandate holders of the Human Rights Council, of 18 June 2007, and stressing that the mandate holder shall discharge his/her duties in accordance with these resolutions and annexes thereto,

- 1. —1. —Decides to extend the mandate of the Special Rapporteur on contemporary forms of racism, racial discrimination, xenophobia and related intolerance for a further period of three years in accordance with the terms of reference contained in Council resolution 7/34 of 28 March 2008;
- 2. Requests all Governments to cooperate fully with the Special Rapporteur in the discharge of his/her mandate, including by responding promptly to the

- Special Rapporteur's communications, including urgent appeals, and by providing the information requested;
- 3. Requests the Special Rapporteur to submit an annual report to the Human Rights Council and to the United Nations General Assembly, covering all activities relating to his/her mandate undertaken during the year, bearing in mind the importance of ensuring complementarity and with a view to maximising the benefits of the reporting to both bodiesprocess,
- 4. —2. Requests the Special Rapporteur to submit an annual report to the Human Rights Council and the General Assembly, covering all activities relating to his/her mandate undertaken during the year, bearing in mind the importance of ensuring complementarity and maximizing the benefits of reporting to both bodies;
- Requests the Secretary-General and the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights to provide the Special Rapporteur with all the human, technical and financial assistance necessary for the effective fulfilment of his/her mandate;
- 6. -4. Decides to remain seized of this priority issue.
