AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. LEE

Viz:

1 At the end of subtitle H of title X, add the following:

2 **SEC. 1082. REPORT ON UNITED STATES CONTRIBUTIONS TO**

3 **THE UNITED NATIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after the

5 date of the enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter,

6 the Director of the Office of Management and Budget

7 shall submit to Congress a report on all assessed and vol-

8 untary contributions, including in-kind, of the United

9 States Government to the United Nations and its affli-

1 ated agencies and related bodies during the previous fiscal  
2 year.

3 (b) CONTENT.—The report required under subsection  
4 (a) shall include the following elements:

5 (1) The total amount of all assessed and vol-  
6 untary contributions, including in-kind, of the  
7 United States Government to the United Nations  
8 and United Nations affiliated agencies and related  
9 bodies.

10 (2) The approximate percentage of United  
11 States Government contributions to each United Na-  
12 tions affiliated agency or body in such fiscal year  
13 when compared with all contributions to such agency  
14 or body from any source in such fiscal year.

15 (3) For each such contribution—

16 (A) the amount of the contribution;

17 (B) a description of the contribution (in-  
18 cluding whether assessed or voluntary);

19 (C) the department or agency of the  
20 United States Government responsible for the  
21 contribution;

22 (D) the purpose of the contribution; and

23 (E) the United Nations or United Nations  
24 affiliated agency or related body receiving the  
25 contribution.

1           (c) SCOPE OF INITIAL REPORT.—The first report re-  
2           quired under subsection (a) shall include the information  
3           required under this section for the previous three fiscal  
4           years.

5           (d) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF INFORMATION.—Not  
6           later than 14 days after submitting a report required  
7           under subsection (a), the Director of the Office of Man-  
8           agement and Budget shall post a public version of the re-  
9           port on a text-based, searchable, and publicly available  
10          Internet website.
