One of the root causes of violence in April/May 2021, is the
incitement and falsehoods spread by Palestinians around the planned
eviction of a house in Sheikh Jarrah neighborhood which is illegally
located on land owned by a private Jewish association since the 19 th
century.
For example, a person named Mohammed El-Kurd, who has over
200,000 followers on Twitter, spread lies claiming that
"Israeli settlers steal our homes" and claiming "dispossession"
and "theft" by Israelis who are the legal owners of the land, as
determined by the Court.
He also claimed that Israeli authorities "ethnically cleanse"
Palestinians from Jerusalem.
This person published dozens of misleading tweets which repeat
these falsehoods again and again as well as calling for "strong
resistance".
