	<ul> <li>The Jews aim to destroy the al-Aqsa Mosque, and Muslims are duty-bound to defend it by any means necessary</li> <li>The struggle between Jews and Muslims is an eternal one that appears in the Qur'an</li> <li>"Martyrs" are praiseworthy and will only multiply on the path of jihad until victory.</li> <li>In Raed Salah's view, the entire expanse of the Temple Mount, which comprises 36 acres, is sacred and belongs solely to Muslims—not only the al-Aqsa Mosque area. The Jewish enemy, Salah claims, is deliberately planning a gradual takeover of the site, first by taking control of the gates to the mosque and then by building a Jewish temple in place of the "radiant Dome of the Rock." He asserted as much during a conference he held for members of the Masatab al-IIm ("Benches of Learning") organization on November 27, 2013.</li> </ul>
