Revision to operative paragraph 20

20. Urges all States to employ promote and adopt effective measures to enforce their immigration laws and border controls only by means of duly authorized and trained government officials to enforce their immigration laws and border controls, and to take appropriate and effective measures to deter and prevent private persons or groups from carrying out conduct violating criminal and immigration laws relating to border enforcement and from wrongfully undertaking actions reserved for such to government officials, as well as to prosecute and punish including by prosecuting those violations of the law that may result from such actions conduct;
